Manning and James Alfred Miller who has since died intestate leaving a widow Amanda Miller and five children, to wit: M.D. Miller Jr., John T. Miller, James A. Miller, Wm. Henry Miller and Sallie J. Miller subject to the dower right of the widow of said Moses Miller to wit Mary Miller;
