Martin, 1/5 one fifth to William Merit Martin 1/5 one fifth to Cora Bell Fulton and her heirs 1/5 one fifth to Mrs. Annie Anderson and Fannie W. Helton to receive one fifth to her self and her heirs.

I want my wife Mrs. Eliza A. Martin to have all of my personal property to dispose of at her will including one liberty bond and a few thrift stamps. I want my son William Merit Martin to act as Executor of the real estate to sell the farm and divide the Proceed equally as above stated.
