WILL OF PERLEMA PAROLEE WISDOM

I, Perlema Parolee Wisdom, of Hamilton County, Tennessee, do make, declare and publish this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all former wills by me at any time made.

1. I direct that all my just debts, including funeral expenses and expenses of administration, be paid by my executor, hereinafter named.

2. I give and bequeath my wearing apparel, jewelry, ornaments, ~~household and personal~~ effects to my daughter, ^{Mr.} Jessie Wisdom Lanier.

3. I give such Liberty Bonds and War Savings Stamps as I may own at the time of my death to my grandson Edmund Brook Brantley.

4. I give and bequeath unto the organization conducting the Vine Street orphanage in the City of Chattanooga, Tennessee, the sum of Five Hundred (\$500 00) Dollars

5. I give and bequeath unto the Chattanooga Tuberculosis Sanatorium Association, conducting the sanitarium at Pine Breeze, the sum of Five Hundred (\$500 00) Dollars.

6. I give and bequeath unto the organization conducting the Old Ladies Home, in Ridgedale, a suburb of Chattanooga, Tennessee, the sum of Three Hundred (\$300 00) Dollars.

7. I give and bequeath unto my niece, Perlema Battles, the sum of Five Hundred (\$500 00) Dollars; and to my sister, Mrs. Doyle, the sum of Five Hundred (\$500 00) Dollars.

8. Provided she shall continue to live with me and serve me until my death, I give and bequeath to my colored cook, Margaret Moreland, in recognition of her long and faithful services to me, the sum of Five Hundred (\$500 00) Dollars.

9. Provided he shall continue to live with and serve me until my death, I give and bequeath to Robert Edwards (colored) who has long been my coachman, the sum of Five Hundred (\$500 00) Dollars, in recognition of his faithful service.

10. All the residue and remainder of my estate, of any and every kind and description, whatsoever, whether same shall be real, personal or mixed, of which I may die seized and possessed, or to which I may be in any way entitled, I give, devise and bequeath in equal portions to my grandson Edmund Brook Brantley; my granddaughter, Attie Chapman Milligan; and my granddaughter, Katherine Lanier Jones.

11. I nominate and appoint American Trust and Banking Company, of Chattanooga, Tennessee, to be the executor of his my last will and testament.
